# CONSENT OF PARENTS AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

## 1. Statement of Health

I, as the Applicant's parent or legal guardian, agree to authorize Maple Academy to act for me in any emergency, accident or illness during the period of time that the applicant is registered in. The applicant is not affected by or does not have a history of medical, psychiatric, or emotional difficulties nor does the applicant student have any condition that would impact the student's ability to be successful as an international student in Maple Academy Program. If you have any medical conditions or allergy, then please specify below:

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## 2. Medical Release

I grant Maple Academy custody of the participant while in Canada including, but not limited to, all necessary functions to act as legal guardian and "in loco parentis" in any situation, especially in emergencies, including the possibility of permission for surgical operations, or any other medical treatment. Maple Academy shall be the only agency to authorize any medical or mental health treatment of the participant.

I authorize Maple Academy to return him/her to his/her country of origin at his/her cost or that of his/her parents, if necessary at its own discretion, to submit to medical treatment, after consultation with medical authorities. I confirm that at the time of signing this document the participant enjoys satisfactory health. I grant Maple Academy permission to act on our behalf in anything pertaining to possible representation before the local authorities. This authorization shall be valid for the entire duration of Maple Academy Program in which the student is participating.

## 3. Risk Waiver

In consideration of Maple Academy Program inclusive of all local school activities, offering my son or daughter an opportunity to participate in a high-risk outdoor recreational program, including but not limited to kayaking, climbing, hiking, canoeing, snowboarding, skiing and surfing, I agree to waive any and all claims I may have against, and release from all liability for any personal injury, death, property damage or loss sustained as a result of my son or daughter's participation in the activity arising out of any cause whatsoever, including negligence.

I hereby give my consent, and acknowledge by my signature that:

My son or daughter has no illnesses, allergies or disabilities that may require special attention. I am aware of the usual risks and dangers inherent in participation in all of the activities associated with any kind of program. The dangers and risks may include, but are not limited to: Rugged terrain, Rock fall and avalanches, Weather, The possibility that your student may not heed safety instructions or restrictions given to the group, Equipment breakages, failures or Delayed rescue, accessibility or Conduct of the guide, chaperone or other group members. My son or daughter and I understand the Code of Conduct of Maple Academy, local school and any other program that my son or daughter participates in. I will be responsible for any costs caused by my child's failure to abide by the Code of Conduct, including any costs to send him or her home. Accidents can be the result of the nature of the activity and can occur with or without any fault on either the part of the student, or Maple Academy or the school (board) or its employees or agents, or the facility where the activity is taking place.

## 4. Individual Trip, Hangout and Sleepover

In the event that my son or daughter wishes to participate in individual trips, hangouts and sleepovers upon his/her own decision, I understand that it is required to obtain a written approval by Maple Academy in advance.

## 5. Student Agreement

I agree to obey and uphold the following rules and regulations:

- ① Violence and Drinking of alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- ② Use of non-prescription drugs is prohibited.
- ③ Operation of motor vehicles is prohibited.
- ④ Complying with all school and dormitory rules and all Canadian laws is obligatory.
- ⑤ Receiving more than three notices will result in the removal of program.
- ⑥ I must return to my home country within the time limit prescribed in my study permit.
- ⑦ In the event of problems, I will contact Maple Academy supervisor or staff before I contact my parents or the representative in my country.
- ⑧ While living in the dormitory, I agree to regard supervisors and staff as my own parents, and respect them in every way. I understand that I will not be staying as a guest in the dormitory, but as a family member, as is proper and usual in the country.
- ⑨ I understand that a good academic effort will be expected of me while participating in the program. I understand that should I exhibit disruptive behaviour that might result in my suspension or removal from Maple Academy program or school, I may be sent home at my own expense.

If I do not respect the rules outlined above, I understand that I may be sent home at my own expense and no refund will be made. I further understand that as a representative of my homeland, I must be a good citizen and uphold and obey the laws of my host country.
